### FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

Fun with 2025!

Keeping with my tradition, here's a look at all of the Books of the Bible with 20 chapters and 25 verses –

Exodus 20:25 - If you make an altar of stone for Me, you shall not build it of cut stones, for if you wield your tool on it, you will profane it.

<u>Leviticus 20:25</u> - You are therefore to make a distinction between the clean animal and the unclean, and between the unclean bird and the clean; and you shall not make yourselves detestable by animal or by bird or by anything that creeps on the ground, which I have separated for you as unclean.

<u>Numbers 20:25</u> - Take Aaron and his son Eleazar and bring them up to Mount Hor;

<u>Judges 20:25</u> - Benjamin went out against them from Gibeah the second day and felled to the ground again 18,000 men of the sons of Israel; all these drew the sword.

<u>1 Samuel 20:25</u> - The king sat on his seat as usual, the seat by the wall; then Jonathan rose up and Abner sat down by Saul's side, but David's place was empty.

**2 Samuel 20:25** - and Sheva was scribe, and Zadok and Abiathar were priests;

<u>1 Kings 20:25</u> - and muster an army like the army that you have lost, horse for horse, and chariot for chariot. Then we will fight against them in the plain, and surely we will be stronger than they." And he listened to their voice and did so.

2 Chronicles 20:25 - When Jehoshaphat and his people came to take their spoil, they found much among them, including goods, garments and valuable things which they took for themselves, more than they could carry. And they were three days taking the spoil because there was so much.

Job 20:25 - "It is drawn forth and comes out of his back, even the glittering point from his gall. Terrors come upon him,

<u>Proverbs 20:25</u> - It is a trap for a man to say rashly, "It is holy!" And after the vows to make inquiry.
