The Last Time

In our current study of Acts we are about to witness the last free moments of the Apostle Paul's life. He will, for the remainder of his life, be a prisoner.

Although he will be a prisoner, he will in no way slow down in his evangelistic efforts to share the Gospel with as many people as possible.

I'm not surprised by Paul anymore. Since his conversion, he has consistently followed Jesus with an unstoppable enthusiasm. No form of persecution has stopped him.

But he wasn't a superhero. He didn't have supernatural strength of body or mind. By his own admission he wrote,

"For we do not want you to be unaware, brethren, of our affliction which came to us in Asia, that we were burdened excessively, beyond our strength, so that we despaired even of life;" 2 Corinthians 1:8

The way Paul lived encourages me to strive to follow more and to live better. But how? What is the first step I should take in order to move toward a goal like that?

The answer is simple, but not easy. The answer lies in increasing the priority of knowing and following Jesus. In whatever circumstances Paul found himself, he never stopped trying to know Jesus more.

Alone, prioritizing Jesus is hard, but not impossible. Let's help one another and prioritize Jesus together.

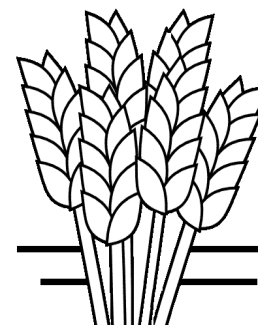
